A. Call to Order:

E. Old Business

- a. Update on Limited License Issue
 - i. Dr. Seiler discussed that the Limited License is for 30 hours and the issue is that it is unclear if that is 30 hours of license mandated interpreting or any interpreting. It was determined that it is for 30 hours of license mandated interpreting. He also stated that if the new bill were to be passed, this issue would be moot as all interpreters would need to be licensed to interpret in Nebraska.
 - ii. Dr. Seiler also stated that this board should look at the cost of licensing once the new bill passes. He would like to compare to surrounding state licensures.
- b. License Application modifications
 - i. Ms. Cooney explained the changes that have been made to all licensing applications.

- 1. wording regarding criminal history was changed
- 2. initial application is now separate application from renewal/reinstatement
- 3. layout of the applications was changed a bit
- c. New license cost language
 - Ms. Cooney mentioned that the initial license application for Interpreter/Transliterator states \$150 for two years. Therefore, the licensing fee really cost \$150.00 up to June 30th of the oddnumbered years. Mr. Sparks will get language regarding cost to put on the applications from Mr. Montgomery.

F. New Business

- a. Updates
 - i. Review new legislative bill and discuss strategies for passage
 - Dr. Seiler explained the amendments to the current licensure bill to the members of this board. One of the amended language (p.9, (e)) was a concern to Ms. Richardson-Nelson. This language stated that if an interpreter is licensed or certified in a state adjacent to Nebraska, that interpreter does not need to have a Nebraska license also. Ms. Richardson-Nelson feels that this creates unfair labor competition for the Nebraska licensed interpreters and should be removed. Dr Seiler stated that he will contact Senator Haar's office to share this concern. The rest of the board members concurred with Ms. Richardson-Nelson.
 - 2. Discussion took place regarding the rest of the changes to the bill. Members also discussed ideas on how to get deaf members of the community to be in attendance for the bill presentation to legislature.
 - ii. Review of states with regard to licensure
 - 1. Mr. Sparks presented information to board members regarding the licensing of interpreters in other states. He will send this information to members by email.
- b. State Assessment Review: Discussion
 - i. Due to time constraints for this board meeting, Dr. Seiler recommended postponing this topic until the next board meeting.
